For Your Information:

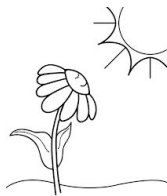
1. The School Board's next regular meeting will be June 19th at 7 p.m. Please contact Mr. Russell or Mr. Jim Tinkey if you have items that need to

2. Final Registration and payment of fees for the 2017-2018 school year will take place Tuesday, July 25 from 3 – 5 pm or 6 – 8 pm and Wednesday, July 26 from 9 – 11:30 am. If these times are not convenient please call for an appointment (574-546-2790).

Generally, if Bremen Public Schools are closed or delayed, so is St. Paul's. In the event of a 2 hour delay Preschool and Kindergarten will start at 10 a.m.
