**Show and Tell:** Show and tell is a way for children to develop verbal and social skills.

The children in the Pre-kindergarten will be bringing home the Me Bag one week this year. (We choose 1 child at a time.) The child may fill the bag with several pictures or things that tell something about him or her. A note will accompany the bag.

The children in the Beginner class will have show and tell once or twice a month and will be asked to bring specific things. Watch the newsletters for dates and directions. Their next show and tell will be September 7. They should bring circle things to share, in the bag provided in their first day folder. On September 21 they should bring square things.

The children are very disappointed when they don't have something to share. Your help with this is appreciated.

**Snacks:** Your assistance in providing nutritious snacks is greatly appreciated! Please feel free to sign up on the bulletin board in the hallway. At the present time the number of students on most days is around 20. There are 4 teachers. Reminder notes are sent home for those who sign up.

**Book Club:** The September Firefly Book Club order form was in student folders the first day of school. The due date for ordering books is September 8. Please make checks payable to St. Paul's Lutheran Preschool.

**Chapel:** Every other week Pastor Wonnacott will be leading a short chapel service for the preschool children. During the chapel songs are sung and Pastor has a brief message. Parents may stay and attend chapel with their child at 9:30. The next chapel is September 8. We will be having chapel time with our St. Paul's K -8 students on the last Wednesday of each month at 11 am.,

**All School Picnic:** Preschool families are invited to attend a St. Paul's Picnic on September 22 from 5-8 p.m. PTL will provide hot dogs and drinks for supper. All families attending should bring a dish to share. Please plan to join us for food, fellowship, games.

**Family Info:** Please notify us of any changes that occur in your family (address, sickness, death in the family, etc.) so we can better serve your child.

**Book Bags:** If at all possible, please provide your child with a book bag backpack to hold papers, projects, and library books that are brought home. PLEASE TAKE TIME TO REMOVE AND LOOK AT YOUR CHILD'S WORK AND OTHER IMPORTANT PAPERS! When sending payments or notes to preschool, it would be helpful to put them in the main pocket of the child's school bag. We check those pockets daily.

**School Directory:** St. Paul's PTL will be publishing a school directory for each preschool family. They will include addresses and phone numbers. If you do not want your phone number published, please let Mrs. Ryan know as soon as possible.

**Toys and Books:** We ask that children not bring toys from home to play with during playtime. Sometimes those toys get mixed up with preschool toys. We have lots of choices for playtime!

**Children's Lending Library:** Children will be allowed to check out 1 library book at a time. Books are checked out for two weeks. Children must return their book before they may check out another one. There is a return basket in the hallway next to Mrs. Cannon's room. If they return their book early, they may check out another during playtime.
